

**Agreement
on scientific cooperation
between
The Faculty of Theology of Leipzig University
and
The Advanced Torah Institute of the University of Bar Ilan**

Preamble

On the basis of the Agreement on Cultural Exchange between the Federal Republic of Germany and The State of Israel, this Agreement shall regulate the terms and conditions for the scientific cooperation between the Faculty of Theology of Leipzig University and the Advanced Torah Institute of Bar Ilan University.

Article 1 - Forms of Cooperation

Cooperation between the two Faculties shall comprise:

- Exchanges of students, scientists and other staff,
- Organization of joint courses,
- Organization of joint research projects,
- Exchange of publications.

Article 2 - Terms & Conditions

The implementation of this agreement shall be dependent upon the annual financial means available. Full use shall be made of all possibilities available for third party financing.

The Faculty that sends visitors on the basis and within the context of the legal regulations shall bear the travel costs for its scientists and other staff. The host Faculty shall make every effort within its possibilities to provide for the cost of the stay and accommodation. The attention of the scientists and other staff involved in the exchange is drawn to the fact that they are themselves responsible for the insurance cover that is an essential requirement of their visit.

Article 3 - Authorized Representatives

Each Faculty shall name an Authorized Representative to the Dean:

- For Leipzig University: Prof. Dr. Alexander Deeg
- For the Bar Ilan University: Rabbi Shabtai A. Rappoport

The Authorized Representatives are responsible for:

- The preparation and carrying out of working programs,
- Coordination with other faculties
- Access to all university facilities that are required for the purposes of the visit; in particular to archives, libraries and computer workstations,
- Coordination with the International Centre, in particular in respect to the exchange of students.


Article 4 – Duration, Termination, Supplement

This agreement is valid from the date of signing by both parties, and this initially for a period of three years. After the expiry of two years, the contracting parties shall check the conditions under which a continuation would appear to be possible. Should no objections be raised to this, the agreement shall be extended by a further three years in each case, when it is not terminated by either one of the contracting parties with a period of six months' notice from the end of the contract. Notice of termination must be in written form.


Protocol records regulating the details of the periods may supplement the agreement and/or projects set down. Any amendments to this agreement require the written consent of both parties.


