

Cooperation Agreement

between

Berlin School of Mind and Brain

and

The Leslie and Susan Gonda (Goldschmied) Multidisciplinary Brain Research Center
Bar-Ilan University

The Berlin School of Mind and Brain wishes to draw on its concentration of research capacity in the mind/brain sciences that is based also on the cooperation with the the Leslie and Susan Gonda (Goldschmied) Multidisciplinary Brain Research Center.

In a mutual desire to intensify the shared efforts to advance the promotion of young academics, especially in the field of postgraduate education, the Berlin School of Mind and Brain and the Leslie and Susan Gonda (Goldschmied) Multidisciplinary Brain Research Center enter this agreement, thereby providing the following framework for their academic cooperation:

- The Berlin School of Mind and Brain and the Leslie and Susan Gonda (Goldschmied) Multidisciplinary Brain Research Center will open to selected Ph.D. students and will provide them the opportunity to participate in their curriculum and to use its facilities as associated members. The opportunities offered by the Berlin School of Mind and Brain and the Leslie and Susan Gonda (Goldschmied) Multidisciplinary Brain Research Center should comply with the individual needs of the Ph.D. students.
- Members of the Berlin School of Mind and Brain and of the Leslie and Susan Gonda (Goldschmied) Multidisciplinary Brain Research Center will contribute to each other's research. Members include professors, postdoctoral research fellows, doctoral students and Master's students.

The fields of scientific cooperation are to be termed in each single case, based on mutual interests. The conditions of the arrangement of mutual exchange of academic matter and personnel have to be authorized by the cooperation partners from case to case, where appropriate.


Detailed provisions governing individual projects shall be stipulated in separate agreements in written form where appropriate.

Each party shall keep confidential any information that it receives from the other party which is marked confidential.

The parties understand that all financial arrangements will depend upon availability of funds in each specific case. In general, all costs arising from this cooperation shall be borne by the party where the costs occur unless other provisions are made in advance.


This agreement will become effective upon legally binding signature by the representatives of the participating parties and will be valid for an initial period of five years from that effective date. This agreement may be terminated by each party upon six weeks' written notice to the other party. The agreement will be subject to review not less than six months prior to the termination of the initial five-year period and may be extended by mutual agreement in writing. Changes or amendments of this agreement are possible at any time in writing.
