

# EP PerMed: Joint Transnational Call for Proposals (JTC2026)



“Personalised Medicine for CARdiovascular, MEtabolic, and kidNey diseases”  
(CARMEN2026)

- *Aim: Fund research projects developing **innovative personalised medicine strategies for patients with cardiovascular, metabolic, and/or kidney diseases**, focusing on personalised therapeutic approaches, monitoring of treatment response to tailor care, and early risk prediction and prevention of disease progression or comorbidities.*
- Preproposal Submission Deadline: **10 February 2026** | 15:00 (Israel time)
- Partners: 3-6 from at least 3 participating countries (at least 2 from EU/associated countries);
- Budget: 140,000 € (+40,000 € for coordinator) – 3 years
- Patient Engagement – involvement of patients is highly encouraged – up to 50,000€ can be requested from EP PerMed by eligible patient organizations that participate as partners.

# EP PerMed: Twinning Call 2026

“Advancing Collaborative Implementation of Personalised Medicine Approaches in Healthcare”



- *Aim: Accelerate the implementation of personalised medicine solutions across countries through structured peer-to-peer “Twinning” partnerships that transfer knowledge/expertise/approaches from experienced “Twinning Donors” to “Twinning Receivers”.*
- Call launch: **10 December 2025 (early matchmaking open)**
- Submission Deadline: **26 February 2026** | 16:00 (Israel time)
- Partners: 2-3 – 1 donor and 1-2 receiver(s); 2-3 participating countries
- Budget: up to 50,000 - up to 6 grants
- Duration: 6-12 months

- *Aim: Strengthen evidence generation, support regulatory preparedness, and accelerate the route to market for promising personalised medicine solutions. The programme helps early-stage innovations progress by at least one TRL through dedicated validation studies carried out together with specialised European validation centres.*
- Submission Deadline: **10 March 2026** | 17:00 (Israel time)
- Eligible applicants: Start-up companies; Small teams/researchers from academic or healthcare research organisations, intending to spin out a start-up.
- Budget: up to 80,000€ - up to 5 grants
- Duration: 6 months

- Aim: *Solve undiagnosed rare genetic diseases and to address complex, multifactorial rare non-genetic diseases by identifying causative variants in patients with no molecular diagnosis after prior genetic or genomic testing and providing **diagnostic clarity** for conditions of unknown or mixed pathogenesis.*
- Preproposal Submission Deadline: **12 February 2026**
- Partners: 4-6 from at least 4 participating countries; Additional 1-2 partners allowed if ECR/UC
- Budget: 140,000 € (+40,000 € for coordinator) – 3 years
- **Patient Engagement** – involvement of patients/patient organizations is very highly recommended! (see [guide](#))
- SME/Industry: Allowed (NOT funded by CSO-MOH)

## ERDERA: Networking Support Scheme (NSS)

A competitive funding instrument for networking events to share knowledge on rare diseases and rare cancers

- Aim: Support **transnational networking events** with a **clear rare disease or rare cancer patient-oriented research focus** that promote scientific knowledge exchange among clinicians, researchers and patients, while **enhancing the participation of underrepresented countries (UC)** in these research networks.
- Constantly open call (until April 2029), with a collection point every 6 months
- Current round deadline: **7 April 2026 | 15:00 Israel time**
- Eligibility:
  - 3-10 partners from at least 3 eligible countries (at least 1 from UC)
  - Applicants: researchers, clinicians, research managers, patient organizations (PAOs).
  - Encouraged participation of early career researchers and PAOs
  - Hybrid or physical meeting (not solely online)
- Budget: up to 30,000 € per networking event

# OH-TREAT: Treatments and Adherence to treatment protocols

## Topics: (Can only apply to one topic)

1. Identify and develop new combination treatments using existing or innovative antimicrobials.
2. Develop tools and methods to improve adherence to treatment protocols.
3. Assess the impact of antimicrobials for veterinary and agricultural use on the risk of AMR transmission to humans and the environment to inform policies on the restriction of some antimicrobials for human use.
